Volunteer Descriptions

Saturday, April 27th, 2019 - Spread the Word and Volunteer!

We have short volunteer shifts to increase flexibility for “play” time, but encourage volunteers to take two shifts if they can.

Parking Assistants:

Parking assistants will help instruct event participants where to park. The parking area is a grassy field, so direction will be needed on where to go, and exactly where to park. Keep in mind volunteers will spend their shift standing in what we hope will be bright sunshine.

Registration Assistants:

Registration Assistants will hand out maps, help participants sign event waivers, suggest a donation, hand out T-shirts, orient participants to the general area, and give instruction on where to meet for organized hikes. We will have a couple of expert “floaters” always on hand to answer questions throughout the day.

Hike Leader Assistants:

These volunteers will aid hike leaders in managing hike groups and assist in carrying any supplies (first aid kit, etc.) needed. They will assist individuals back to main area if unwilling or unable to continue hiking. Hikes range from 1-4 miles, approximately one hike leader assistant needed per hike.
